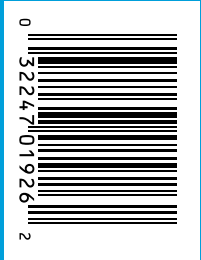

*If seed is watered and soil is warm. Results may vary due to environmental factors. Allow up to 40 days for full germination, especially if temperatures are lower than 60°F and adequate moisture is not available.

Best Times To Seed

Spring and fall are the best times to plant. Seed germinates best when temperatures are consistently 60° to 80°F

Spring: Early spring, when temperatures are 40° to 70°F is the ideal time to seed (freezing temperatures will not harm the seed or young seedlings, but will delay emergence by one to several weeks). Early spring planting generally results in better establishment than late spring. Seed will not germinate well once temperatures are consistently above 80°F

Fall: Seed when the daily high temperatures are consistently below 80°F In many areas this is actually the late summer. Seeding should be completed 6 to 8 weeks before temperatures are expected to fall below 40°F

Planting Instructions



Loosen soil

Overseeding – mow grass closely, then loosen top 1/4 inch of soil in bare and thin areas.

New lawn seeding – loosen top 2 to 3 inches of soil to provide a lodging place for the seeds.



Plant the seed

Distribute the seed evenly. For best results, always use a Scotts® brand spreader. The following spreader settings are recommended:

Apply Fertilizer and Water

Apply Scotts Starter® Fertilizer and then water thoroughly.

WATERING IS CRUCIAL TO SEEDING SUCCESS.



Keep the top 1/2 inch of soil damp by watering twice daily until all seedlings are up. Continue to water once or twice a day until the lawn is fully established (6 to 8 weeks).



Feed New Grass Plants

In 4 to 6 weeks, make an application of Scotts Turf Builder® Lawn Fertilizer. This helps the plants knit together to form a thick, green carpet of grass.

Do not apply a weed control product until after at least 3 mowings. Mow new seedlings as soon as they reach normal mowing height (3 inches or more).
